Call for applications



Deadline to receive applications: December 19,2021 at midnight.

In 2022, the Roquette Foundation for Health will award its second research prize of 25,000 euros. The award is aimed at young researchers under 40 years old (at the closing date for applications), registered in a university or school in the following countries: France, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, Lithuania, Germany, Belgium, Finland, Poland. The research prize rewards or supports any particularly innovative research, thesis, dissertation, or publication that answers the following question:

Prevention in Health: what are the challenges and strategies around food and nutrition?

It is understood that this question concerns only <u>human food</u>.

To be eligible, the work must come from research, whatever the discipline–basic research, clinical research, human and social sciences–and must be publishable in order to meet the general interest. A candidate may submit only one application for the 2022 edition.

The prize, endowed with 25,000 euros, will be awarded to the winner (up to 10,000 euros) and to his or her team within the laboratory (up to 15,000 euros) for the continuation of the prize-winning work.

This file must include the following elements:

- Application form
- Letter of motivation (500 words max)
- Summary of the research project (1 page max)
- Research project file (5 pages max)
- Curriculum vitae
- Organization chart of the laboratory
- Form of contract for the cessation of image rights

All documents must be submitted on the submission platform in PDF format in French or English. No application received by post will be considered.

Applications will be evaluated by a committee of experts. Decisions will only be communicated electronically during the first half of 2022. The prize will be awarded during a research ceremony, planned for the first half of 2022 in Lille (date to be confirmed).
